



## **The 24<sup>th</sup> Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Sepak Takraw**

---

Whereas it is expedient to have the 24<sup>th</sup> Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Sepak Takraw;

By virtue of Article 8 (2) of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2562 (2019), the regulation has been issued as follows:

Article 1: This regulation is called “the 24<sup>th</sup> Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Sepak Takraw”.

Article 2: This regulation shall be enforced in the 24<sup>th</sup> Thailand Sports School Games on Sepak Takraw.

Article 3: Rules and regulation of the competition

3.1 The 24<sup>th</sup> Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Sepak Takraw shall be applied.

3.2 The rules of the Takraw Association of Thailand shall be applied.

3.3 The 24<sup>th</sup> Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Sepak Takraw shall be applied in case of disagreement.

Article 4: Age groups, types, and events of the competition

4.1 Ages are classified into 3 groups as follows:

(1) U14 (not born before 2009)

(2) U16 (born between 2007 - 2008)

(3) U18 (born between 2005 - 2006)

4.2 The competition is divided into 2 types as follows:

(1) Boys' team

(2) Girls' team

4.3 The Competition is divided into 3 events as follows;

(1) Team

(2) Regu

(3) Double

#### Article 5: The number of athletes and team officials

5.1 Each sports school is allowed to send one team in each age group both boys and girls to compete. The participating athletes are allowed to compete in only one age group with a maximum of two events.

5.2 For Team event, the list with a minimum of 9 athletes and a maximum of 15 athletes is allowed to submit. The said list must be cut off to 12 athletes on the day of team managers' meeting.

5.3 For Regu event, the list with a minimum of 3 athletes and a maximum of 5 athletes is allowed to submit on the day of team managers' meeting.

5.4 For Double event, the list with a minimum of two athletes and a maximum of 3 athletes is allowed to submit. The said list must not be the same as in the Regu's list on the day of team managers' meeting.

5.5 The athletes who will compete in the Regu or the Double must have their names in the Team's list.

5.6 Team officials of each event and each age group consist of:

- |                     |   |        |

#### Article 6: Qualifications of athletes

The qualifications shall be based upon Section 5 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E 2562 (2019).

#### Article 7: The competition prizes

7.1 Winning athletes shall receive the competition prizes in accordance with Section 7, Article 21 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2562 (2019) as follows:

- (1) The winner shall receive gold-plated medal and certificate
- (2) The first runner-up shall receive silver-plated medal and certificate
- (3) The second runner-up shall receive bronze-plated medal and certificate

7.2 For the trophy of honor, sports school which receives the most gold medals shall be considered a winner. If the number of gold medals is equal, the number of silver and bronze medals shall be considered respectively. And if the number of all types of medals is equal, the trophy of honor shall be occupied together.

#### 7.3 Excellent athlete and coach awards

Excellent athlete and coach shall receive a certificate of honor under the criteria of consideration as follows:

- (1) The excellent athlete awards shall be given to three boys and three girls in accordance with their age groups (U14, U16, and U18).
- (2) The excellent coach awards shall be given to three boys' coaches and three girls' coaches in accordance with their age groups (U14, U16, and U18).
- (3) The operating sub-committee in the Sepak Takraw sport technical sub-committee shall consider and operate for the excellent athlete and coach awards.

## Article 8: The competition organizing methods

### 8.1 The competition organizing methods are as follows:

(1) If there are more than 5 teams participating in the Team, Regu, and Double events, the competition shall be as follows:

- Round 1: a group division shall be made and a single round-robin competition in a group shall be organized.

- Round 2 to the final: a single-elimination competition shall be organized.

(2) If there are no more than 5 teams participating in the Team, Regu, and Double events, the competition shall be as follows:

- A single round-robin competition shall be organized and the teams which have the first, second, and third placing points shall receive the prize in accordance with Section 7, Article 21 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2562 (2019).

(3) Winning teams in the semifinal shall get through to compete in the final. Losing teams in the semifinal shall be given the second runner-up prize together.

### 8.2 The competition result shall be considered winning-losing as follows:

(1) For Team event, the best-of-three-team winning-losing format shall be applied and the best-of-three-set winning-losing format shall be applied for each team. If any team has already won over two opponent teams, there will be no match for the third team.

(2) For Regu event, the best-of-three-set winning-losing format shall be applied.

(3) For Double event, the best-of-three-set winning-losing format shall be applied.

### 8.3 Scoring for Sepak Takraw

- Winning team gets 3 points

- Losing team gets 1 point

- No match gets 0 point

8.4 If the points are equal, drawing lots shall be made to find out the winning team.

### 8.5 The competition practices

(1) Team manager must submit the list of athletes to the registrar 30 minutes before the competition.

(2) Participating athletes must accept a verdict and be strictly cooperative on working of the organizing sub-committee and referees.

(3) Any team which is not ready for the competition when the specific time has gone over 15 minutes shall be judged as a losing team. The sport technical sub-committee shall also propose for the penalty consideration in accordance with the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2562 (2019).

(4) Participating athletes of any team who do not come and compete on the specific date, time, and venue without notification of proper reason or intend to violate a command of the organizing sub-committee or the referee shall be judged as a losing team and also the organizing sub-committee shall propose for the penalty consideration

in accordance with the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2562 (2019).

Article 9: Determination of the competition date, time and venues

The organizing committee shall be responsible for determination of the competition date, time and venues.

Article 10: The competition uniform and equipment

The competition uniform and equipment shall be based upon the rules and regulation of the Takraw Association of Thailand.

Article 11: Referees and officials

The sport technical sub-committee shall consider under an approval of the organizing committee.

Article 12: Protests and appeal

12.1 The protests and appeal shall be based upon Section 8 and Section 10 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2562 (2019).

12.2 Lodging the sport technical protest must be done within 12 hours after the competition result has been officially announced.

12.3 Lodging the athlete qualification protest must be done within 24 hours after the competition result is officially announced.

Article 13: Penalty

The penalty shall be based upon Section 9 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2562 (2019).

Article 14: Chairperson of the 24<sup>th</sup> Thailand Sports School Games Organizing Committee shall have charge and control of the execution of this regulation and act as an arbiter in case of any problems which may occur from applying this regulation.
