



## **The 24<sup>th</sup> Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Swimming**

---

Whereas it is expedient to have the 24<sup>th</sup> Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Swimming;

By virtue of Article 8 (2) of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2562 (2019), the regulation has been issued as follows:

Article 1: This regulation is called “the 24<sup>th</sup> Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Swimming”.

Article 2: This regulation shall be enforced in the 24<sup>th</sup> Thailand Sports School Games on Swimming.

Article 3: Rules and regulation of the competition

3.1 The 24<sup>th</sup> Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Swimming shall be applied.

3.2 The rules of the International Swimming Federation shall be applied.

3.3 The 24<sup>th</sup> Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Swimming shall be applied in case of disagreement.

Article 4: Age groups, types, and events of the competition

4.1 Ages are classified into 3 groups as follows:

- (1) U14 (not born before 2009)
- (2) U16 (born between 2007 - 2008)
- (3) U18 (born between 2005 - 2006)

4.2 The competition is divided into 2 types as follows;

- (1) Individual
  - Boys' individual
  - Girls' individual
- (2) Team
  - Boys' team
  - Girls' team

## 4.3 The competition events are as follows:

## Article 5: The number of athletes and team officials

5.1 A maximum of 30 athletes in each age group is allowed in the competition. The above mentioned number shall be divided into a maximum of 15 boys and a maximum of 15 girls.

5.2 For individual type, a maximum of 2 athletes is allowed to register in each event.

5.3 For team type, a maximum of 1 team is allowed to register in each event.

5.4 Each athlete is allowed to compete in his/her age group only with a maximum of 3 events whether in the individual or team type.

## 5.5 Team officials in each age group are as follows:

## Article 6: Qualifications of athletes

The qualifications shall be based upon Section 5 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E 2562 (2019).

Article 7: The competition prizes

7.1 Winning athletes shall receive the competition prizes in accordance with Section 7, Article 21 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2562 (2019) as follows:

- (1) The winner shall receive gold-plated medal and certificate.
- (2) The first runner-up shall receive silver-plated medal and certificate.
- (3) The second runner-up shall receive bronze-plated medal and certificate.

7.2 Sports school which has the highest total scores shall receive a trophy of honor in accordance with Section 7, Article 22 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2562 (2019). The point calculation shall be as follows:

7.3 Excellent athlete and coach awards

Excellent athlete and coach shall receive a certificate of honor under the criteria of consideration as follows:

- (1) The excellent athlete awards shall be given to three boys and three girls in accordance with their age groups (U14, U16, and U18).
- (2) The excellent coach awards shall be given to three boys' coaches and three girls' coaches.
- (3) The operating sub-committee in the swimming sport technical sub-committee shall consider and operate for the excellent athlete and coach awards.

Article 8: The competition organizing methods

8.1 Time final method shall be applied and the competition program shall be based upon the Thailand Swimming Association.

8.2 Determination of swimming lanes shall be based upon the rules of the International Swimming Federation (FINA).

8.3 Athletes must come for self-reporting 30 minutes prior to the competition.

8.4 One start rule shall be applied for releasing.

8.5 Organized events shall have to consist of athletes coming from at least 3 sports schools. Any events consisting of athletes coming from less than 3 sports schools shall be considered a tryout.

8.6 Automatic stopwatch shall be used.

8.7 A verdict of the sport technical sub-committee shall be considered in case of any occurred problems.

Article 9: Determination of the competition date, time and venues

The organizing committee shall be responsible for determination of the competition date, time and venues.

Article 10: The competition uniform and equipment

The competition uniform and equipment shall be based upon the rules and regulation of the International Swimming Federation.

Article 11: Referees and officials

The sport technical sub-committee shall consider under an approval of the organizing committee.

Article 12: Protests and appeal

The protests and appeal shall be based upon Section 8 and Section 10 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2562 (2019).

Article 13: Penalty

The penalty shall be based upon Section 9 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2562 (2019).

Article 14: Chairperson of the 24<sup>th</sup> Thailand Sports School Games Organizing Committee shall have charge and control of the execution of this regulation and act as an arbiter in case of any problems which may occur from applying this regulation.
