



The 24th Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Volleyball

Whereas it is expedient to have the 24th Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Volleyball;

By virtue of Article 8 (2) of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2562 (2019), the regulation has been issued as follows:

Article 1: This regulation is called “the 24th Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Volleyball”.

Article 2: This regulation shall be enforced in the 24th Thailand Sports School Games on Volleyball.

Article 3: Rules and regulation of the competition

3.1 The 24th Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Volleyball shall be applied.

3.2 The rules of the Thailand Volleyball Association shall be applied.

3.3 The 24th Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Volleyball shall be applied in case of disagreement.

Article 4: Age groups and types of the competition

4.1 Ages are classified into 3 groups as follows:

- (1) U14 (not born before 2009)
- (2) U16 (born between 2007 - 2008)
- (3) U18 (born between 2005 - 2006)

4.2 The competition is divided into 2 types as follows:

- (1) Boys' team
- (2) Girls' team

Article 5: The number of athletes and team officials

5.1 Each sports school is allowed to send one team to compete in each age group both boys' team and girls' team with a minimum of 6 athletes and maximum of 20 athletes.

5.2 Team manager must confirm the list of competing athletes with a maximum of 14 athletes from the list in Article 5.1 to the organizing committee on the day of team managers' meeting.

5.3 Changes shall not be allowed in any cases after the list is confirmed in accordance with Article 5.2

5.4 Team officials in each team and each age group consist of:

Article 6: Qualifications of athletes

The qualifications shall be based upon Section 5 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E 2562 (2019).

Article 7: The competition prizes

7.1 Winning athletes shall receive the competition prizes in accordance with Section 7, Article 21 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2562 (2019) as follows:

- (1) The winner shall receive gold-plated medal and certificate.
- (2) The first runner-up shall receive silver-plated medal and certificate.
- (3) The second runner-up shall receive bronze-plated medal and certificate.

7.2 Sports school which has the highest total scores shall receive a trophy of honor in accordance with Section 7, Article 22 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2562 (2019).

7.3 Excellent athlete and coach awards

Excellent athlete and coach shall receive a certificate of honor under the criteria of consideration as follows:

- (1) The excellent athlete awards shall be given to three boys and three girls in accordance with their age groups (U14, U16, and U18).
- (2) The excellent coach awards shall be given to one boys' team coach and one girls' team coach.
- (3) The operating sub-committee in the volleyball sport technical sub-committee shall consider and operate for the excellent athlete and coach awards.

Article 8: The competition organizing methods

8.1 Net's height

Boys' team

- (1) For U14: net's height is 2.38 meters.
 - First round: a best-of-five sets format shall be applied.
 - Semifinal: a best-of-five sets format shall be applied.
 - Final: a best-of-five sets format shall be applied.
- (2) For U16: net's height is 2.43 meters.
 - A best-of-five sets format shall be applied.
- (3) For U18: net's height is 2.43 meters.
 - A best-of-five sets format shall be applied.

Girls' team

- (1) For U14: net's height is 2.20 meters.
 - First round: a best-of-five sets format shall be applied.
 - Semifinal: a best-of-five sets format shall be applied.
 - Final: a best-of-five sets format shall be applied.
- (2) For U16: net's height is 2.24 meters.
 - A best-of-five sets format shall be applied.
- (3) For U18: net's height is 2.24 meters.
 - A best-of-five sets format shall be applied.

8.2 Organizing system

- (1) The number of participating teams is not more than 5:
 - First round: a single round-robin competition shall be organized.
 - Second round: teams which get the total points in the first place and second place shall get through to compete in the final. Teams which get the total points in the third place and fourth place shall receive the second runner-up prize together.
- (2) The number of participating teams is more than 5:
 - First round: two groups shall be divided (group A and group B).
 - Second round: teams which get the total points in the first place and second place of each group shall get through to the next round.
 - Semifinal
 - 1) The 1st place of group A versus the 2nd place of group B
 - 2) The 2nd place of group A versus the 1st place of group B
 - Final: winning teams in the semifinal shall get through to compete in the final. Losing teams shall receive the second runner-up prize together.
- (3) Scoring in the competition
 - Team won by 3 : 0, 3 : 1 gets 3 points, team won by 3 : 2 gets 2 points.
 - Team lost by 3 : 0, 3 : 1 gets 0 point, team lost by 2 : 3 gets 1 point.
 - If the points are equal and selecting any teams to the next round has to be made, the consideration shall be based upon the rules of the Thailand Volleyball Association.

8.3 Participating athletes must accept a verdict and be strictly cooperative on working of the sport technical sub-committee, referees, and officials who are on duties.

8.4 Team manager must submit the list of participating athletes in accordance with the registered jersey's number to the sport technical sub-committee one day before the competition.

8.5 Participating athletes of any teams do not come or are not ready to compete on the specific date, time, and venue without proper reason or violate the order of the sport technical sub-committee or of the referees, they shall be given the losing result in accordance with Section 9 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2562 (2019). In such case, the sport technical sub-committee is required to report to the executive committee of the 24th Thailand Sports School Games.

8.6 Athletes must behave with good manners throughout the competition and must strictly follow the rules and regulation.

Article 9: Determination of the competition date, time and venues

The organizing committee shall be responsible for determination of the competition date, time and venues.

Article 10: The competition uniform and equipment

10.1 The competition uniform

(1) All athletes must orderly wear volleyball uniform with the same color as informed (except libero).

(2) Jerseys' number must be clearly labelled on both front and back sides (according to the rules and including team captain's mark).

(3) If any athletes or any teams improperly dresses or violates the rules and regulation, the competition controlling officials shall break the match until dressing has been properly managed.

(4) Coach and assistant coach shall have to dress properly and politely. Sport uniforms or shirts with sport shoes, sneakers, or leather shoes are allowed.

10.2 The competition equipment shall be under the discretion of the organizing committee and certified by the Thailand Volleyball Association.

Article 11: Referees and officials

The sport technical sub-committee shall consider under an approval of the organizing committee.

Article 12: Protests and appeal

The protests and appeal shall be based upon Section 8 and Section 10 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2562 (2019).

Article 13: Penalty

The penalty shall be based upon Section 9 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2562 (2019).

Article 14: Chairperson of the 24th Thailand Sports School Games Organizing Committee shall have charge and control of the execution of this regulation and act as an arbiter in case of any problems which may occur from applying this regulation.
