



The 25th Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Athletics

Whereas it is expedient to have the 25th Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Athletics;

By virtue of Article 8 (2) of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2562 (2019), the regulation has been issued as follows:

Article 1: This regulation is called “the 25th Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Athletics”.

Article 2: This regulation shall be enforced in the 25th Thailand Sports School Games on Athletics.

Article 3: Rules and regulation of the competition

3.1 The 25th Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Athletics shall be applied.

3.2 The rules of the Athletic Association of Thailand Patron: His Majesty the King shall be applied.

3.3 The 25th Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Athletics shall be applied in case of disagreement.

Article 4: Age groups, types, and events of the competition

4.1 Ages are classified into 3 groups as follows:

4.1.1 U14 (not born before 2010)

4.1.2 U16 (born between 2008 - 2009)

4.1.3 U18 (born between 2006 - 2007)

4.2 The competition is divided into 2 types as follows:

4.2.1 Boys

4.2.2 Girls

4.3 The competition events are as follows:

Article 5: The number of athletes and team officials

5.1 One athlete is allowed to compete in one age group only with a maximum of five events.

5.2 Individual events: each sports school is required to send two athletes to compete in each event.

5.3 Relay team events: each sports school is required to send one team consisting of six athletes to compete in each event.

5.4 Team officials of each sports school consist of:

5.4.1 Team manager	1	person
5.4.2 Head coach	1	person
5.4.3 Coach	9	persons

Article 6: Qualifications of athletes

The qualifications shall be based upon Section 5 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E 2562 (2019).

Article 7: The competition prizes

7.1 Winning athletes shall receive the competition prizes in accordance with Section 7, Article 21 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2562 (2019) as follows:

7.1.1 The winner shall receive a gold medal and a certificate.

7.1.2 The first runner-up shall receive a silver medal and a certificate.

7.1.3 The second runner-up shall receive a bronze medal and a certificate.

7.2 The sports school which has the highest total scores shall receive a trophy of honor in accordance with Section 7, Article 22 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2562 (2019). The point calculation shall be as follows:

7.2.1 The 1 st place gets	9	points
7.2.2 The 2 nd place gets	7	points
7.2.3 The 3 rd place gets	6	points
7.2.4 The 4 th place gets	5	points
7.2.5 The 5 th place gets	4	points
7.2.6 The 6 th place gets	3	points
7.2.7 The 7 th place gets	2	points
7.2.8 The 8 th place gets	1	point

7.3 Best athlete and coach awards

The best athlete and coach shall receive a certificate of honor under the criteria of consideration as follows:

7.3.1 The best athlete awards shall be given to three boys and three girls in accordance with their age groups (U14, U16, and U18).

7.3.2 The best coach awards shall be given to three boys' coaches and three girls' coaches.

7.3.3 The operating sub-committee in the athletics sport technical sub-committee shall consider and operate for the best athlete and coach awards.

Article 8: The competition organizing methods

8.1 The competition shall be based upon the rules of the Athletic Association of Thailand Patron: His Majesty the King and the rules of the International Association of Athletics Federations, with the exception of U14 and U16 in the events the distance of which is not more than 400 meters; the competition shall be organized only two rounds which are the qualifying and the final rounds as follows:

In case there are 2 groups of athletes, the 1st - 3rd places of each group and another two athletes who get the best time shall be selected.

In case there are 3 groups of athletes, the 1st - 2nd places of each group and another two athletes who get the best time shall be selected.

In case there are 4 groups of athletes, the 1st place and another four athletes who get the best time shall be selected.

In case there are 5 groups of athletes, the 1st place and another three athletes who get the best time shall be selected.

In case there are 6 groups of athlete and more, the first eight of athletes who get the best time shall get through to the final round.

8.2 Submission of the list for the relay race

8.2.1 Submission of the list in the qualifying round is required to be done one hour before self-reporting time and four athletes are allowed in each event. However, the aforesaid list must be shown in the athletes' form (F2) in their age groups.

8.2.2 Submission of the list in the final round is required to be done one hour before self-reporting time and the list can be changed from the list of athletes in the qualifying round with a maximum of two athletes.

8.3 Pentathlon events in U14

8.3.1 For girls, the events consist of 100 meter hurdles, long jump, shot put, high jump, and 800 meter race.

8.3.2 For boys, the events consist of 110 meter hurdles, long jump, shot put, high jump, and 800 meter race.

8.4 In case there are any problems about the events in the daily competition, the athletics organizing sub-committee shall consider and execute those.

Article 9: Determination of the competition date, time, and venues

The organizing committee shall be responsible for determination of the competition date, time, and venues.

Article 10: The competition uniform and equipment

10.1 Athletes must wear uniform provided by their sports school only.

10.2 Relay team must wear the same uniform in the same color.

10.3 Sizes of the competition equipment in each event and age group are as follows:

Article 11: Referees and officials

The sport technical sub-committee shall consider the referees and the officials for the competition under an approval of the organizing committee.

Article 12: Protest and appeal

12.1 The protest and appeal shall be based upon Section 8 and Section 10 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2562 (2019).

12.2 Lodging the sport technical protest must be done within 30 minutes after the competition result has been officially announced.

Article 13: Penalty

The penalty shall be based upon Section 9 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2562 (2019).

Article 14: Chairperson of the 25th Thailand Sports School Games Organizing Committee shall have charge and control of the execution of this regulation and act as an arbiter in case of any problems which may occur from applying this regulation.
