

The 25th Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Cycling

Whereas it is expedient to have the 25th Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Cycling;

By virtue of Article 8 (2) of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2562 (2019), the regulation has been issued as follows:

Article 1: This regulation is called "the 25th Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Cycling".

Article 2: This regulation shall be enforced in the 25th Thailand Sports School Games on Cycling.

Article 3: Rules and regulation of the competition

3.1 The 25th Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Cycling shall be applied.

3.2 The rules of the Thai Cycling Association and the provisions of the Union Cycling International, latest edition, 2019, shall be applied.

3.3 The 25th Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Cycling shall be applied in case of disagreement.

Article 4: Age groups, types, and events of the competition

4.1 Ages are classified into 3 groups as follows:

4.1.1 U14 (not born before 2010)

4.1.2 U16 (born between 2008 - 2009)

4.1.3 U18 (born between 2006 - 2007)

4.2 The competition is divided into 3 types as follows:

4.2.1 Track cycling (boys - girls)

4.2.2 Road cycling (boys - girls)

4.2.3 Mountain bike (boys - girls)

4.3 The competition events are as follows:

4.3.1 Track cycling

Article 5: The number of athletes and team officials

5.1 One athlete is able to participate in only one age group with a maximum of 3 events.

5.2 Team officials in each age group consist of:

5.1.1 Team manager	1	person
5.1.2 Coach	1	person
5.1.3 Assistant coach	1	person

Article 6: Qualifications of athletes

The qualifications shall be based upon Section 5 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E 2562 (2019).

Article 7: The competition prizes

7.1 Winning athletes shall receive the competition prizes in accordance with Section 7, Article 21 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2562 (2019) as follows:

7.1.1 The winner shall receive a gold medal and a certificate.

7.1.2 The first runner-up shall receive a silver medal and a certificate.

7.1.3 The second runner-up shall receive a bronze medal and a certificate.

7.2 Sports school which has the highest total scores shall receive a trophy of honor in accordance with Section 7, Article 22 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2562 (2019). The point calculation shall be as follows:

7.2.1 The winner gets	10	points
7.2.2 The first runner-up gets	5	points
7.2.3 The second runner-up gets	3	points

7.3 Best athlete and coach awards

Best athlete and coach shall receive a certificate of honor under the criteria of consideration as follows:

7.3.1 The best athlete awards shall be given to three boys and three girls in accordance with their age groups (U14, U16 and U18).

7.3.2 The best coach awards shall be given to one boys' coach and one girls' coach.

7.3.3 The operating sub-committee in the cycling sport technical sub-committee shall consider and operate for the best athlete and coach awards.

Article 8: The competition organizing methods

The competition organizing methods shall be based upon the rules of the Thai Cycling Association and the provisions of the International Cycling Union, latest edition, 2019.

7.1 Road cycling: roads in the competition shall have to be safe.

7.2 Mountain bike: a proper and safe area shall be used as per the rules of mountain bike (cross-country).

7.3 Track cycling: a velodrome only shall be used.

Article 9: Determination of the competition date, time and venues

The organizing committee shall be responsible for determination of the competition date, time and venues.

Article 10: The competition uniform and equipment

10.1 Athletes shall have to wear uniform provided by their sports

school.

10.2 The competition equipment shall be based upon the rules and regulation of the Thai Cycling Association and the provisions of the International Cycling Union.

Article 11: Referees and officials

11.1 The sport technical sub-committee shall consider the referees and the officials for the competition under an approval of the organizing committee.

11.2 Head of the referees shall have to pass the referee training of the Thai Cycling Association.

Article 12: Protest and appeal

The protest and appeal shall be based upon Section 8 and Section 10 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2562 (2019).

Article 13: Penalty

The penalty shall be based upon Section 9 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2562 (2019).

Article 14: Chairperson of the 25th Thailand Sports School Games Organizing Committee shall have charge and control of the execution of this regulation and act as an arbiter in case of any problems which may occur from applying this regulation.
