

# The 26th Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Basketball

Whereas it is expedient to have the  $26^{th}$  Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Basketball;

By virtue of Article 9 (2) of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2568 (2025), the regulation has been issued as follows:

Article 1: This regulation is called "the  $26^{th}$  Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Basketball".

Article 2: This regulation shall be enforced in the 26<sup>th</sup> Thailand Sports School Games on Basketball.

Article 3: Rules and regulation of the competition

3.2 The rules of the Basketball Sport Association of Thailand shall be applied.

 $3.3\,$  The  $26^{th}$  Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Basketball shall be applied in case of disagreement.

Article 4: Age groups and types of the competition

- 4.1 Ages are classified into 3 groups as follows:
  - 4.1.1 U14 (not born before 2011)
  - 4.1.2 U16 (born between 2009 2010)
  - 4.1.3 U18 (born between 2007 2008)
- 4.2 The competition is divided into 2 types as follows:
  - 4.2.1 Men's team
  - 4.2.2 Women's team

### Article 5: The number of athletes and team officials

5.1 Each sports school is permitted to send one team to compete in each age group both men's team and women's team with a minimum of 5 athletes and a maximum of 12 athletes.

5.2 Team officials of each team and each age group consist of:

# Article 6: Qualifications of athletes

The qualifications shall be based upon Section 5 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E 2568 (2025).

### Article 7: The competition prizes

- 7.1 Winning athletes shall receive the competition prizes in accordance with Section 7, Article 22 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2568 (2025) as follows:
  - 7.1.1 The winner shall receive a gold medal and a certificate.
  - 7.1.2 The first runner-up shall receive a silver medal and a certificate.
  - 7.1.3 The second runner-up shall receive a bronze medal and a certificate.
- 7.2 Sports school which has the highest total scores shall receive a trophy of honor in accordance with Section 7, Article 23 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2568 (2025). Criteria of consideration shall be as follows:

Sports school receiving the most gold medals shall be considered the winner. If the number of gold medals is equal, the number of silver and bronze medals shall be considered respectively. And if the number of all types of medals is still equal, the trophy of honor shall be occupied together.

#### 7.3 Best athlete and coach awards

The best athlete and coach shall receive a certificate of honor under the criteria of consideration as follows:

7.3.1 The best athlete awards shall be given to three men and three women in accordance with their age groups (U14, U16 and U18).

7.3.2 The best coach awards shall be given to three men's team coaches and three women's team coaches.

7.3.3 The operating sub-committee in the basketball sport technical sub-committee shall consider and operate for the best athlete and coach awards.

## Article 8: The competition organizing methods

8.1 A single round-robin competition shall be applied if there are 3-5 participating teams. Team having the highest score shall be considered the winner. Teams having scores in second place and third place shall be considered the first runner-up and the second runner-up, respectively.

8.2 Two groups shall be divided If there are 6 participating teams. Each group consists of 3 teams.

8.2.1 A single round-robin competition in each group shall be organized for the first round. Teams having scores in first place and second place shall get through to compete in the semifinal.

8.2.2 In the semifinal, the winner of each group shall have to compete with the second place of another group. Losing teams shall compete for the third place.

8.3 Point calculation in the competition shall be as follows:

8.3.1 Winning team gets 2 points

8.3.2 Losing team gets 1 point

8.3.3 Team that cannot come on time or unable to come for competing shall be judged by the referee as a loser and get 0 point.

8.3.4 If the score of two teams is equal, the head-to-head rule

shall be considered.

8.3.5 If the teams having equal score are more than two, drawing lots shall be applied to select the team getting through to the next round.

8.4 Participating athletes must accept a verdict and be strictly cooperative on working of the sport technical sub-committee, referees, and officials who are on duties.

8.5 Athletes and team officials shall have to bring their ID cards or other cards and show it every time when they have the competition. The sport technical sub-committee may ask for the card or passport (foreign athletes) for verification in case of doubts.

8.6 Athletes shall have to report themselves to the competition officials on the specified time and venue.

8.7 Athletes and team officials must behave in good manners throughout the competition and must strictly follow the rules and regulation. If athletes do not behave in proper manners or violate the rules and regulation of the competition, the sport technical sub-committee shall consider the penalty as appropriate to the case.

8.8 Participating athletes' numbers shall be specified from 00 - 99 and each athlete shall have to stick the number as shown in the athletes' roster.

8.9 Athletes' jersey numbers shall be specified in accordance with Article 10.5 and the jersey must be all in the same color.

8.10 In each match, the list of 12 athletes at the maximum and of 5 athletes at the minimum is permitted to submit.

8.11 Team manager or representative of each sports school shall have to attend team manager's meeting in order to acknowledge practices or agreements. Team manager or representative of any sports school who does not attend the meeting without proper reason shall be deemed to have accepted the meeting's resolution. Any controversy afterwards shall not be accepted.

8.12 Team manager and coach shall have to have their names in the roster of team official and athlete (F2) of the Thailand Sports School Games.

8.13 Athlete who does not compete or coach who is not on duty shall be reported to the chairperson of the sport technical sub-committee with reasons of necessity.

### 8.14 Duration of the competition

8.14.1 For U14, the competition shall be divided into 4 quarters. Each quarter shall have the 8-minute play and the 2-minute interval. There are the 10-minute halftime break and the 4-minute extra time.

8.14.2 For U16 and U18, the competition shall be divided into 4 quarters. Each quarter shall have the 10-minute play and the 2-minute interval. There are the 10-minute halftime break and the 5-minute extra time.

### Article 9: Determination of the competition date, time and venues

The organizing committee shall be responsible for determination of the competition date, time and venues.

### Article 10: The competition uniform and equipment

10.1 Athletes shall have to wear the uniform provided by their sports school.

10.2 The equipment shall be based upon the rules and regulations of the Basketball Sport Association of Thailand.

10.3 If the basketball team's name is shown as the first team on the competition table, players shall have to wear light-colored uniform only and sit on the bench provided on the left-hand side of the technical officials in the basketball court.

10.4 If the basketball team's name is shown on the right-hand side of the competition table, players shall have to wear dark-colored uniform only and sit on the bench provided on the right-hand side of the technical officials in the basketball court.

10.5 If both teams wear uniforms in the same color, team having its name on the left-hand side of the competition table shall have to change the player's uniform. Unless both teams wear in white jersey, team having its name on the right-hand side of the competition table shall have to change the player's uniform.

10.6 The competition equipment shall have to be certified by the Basketball Sport Association of Thailand.

#### Article 11: Referees and officials

The sport technical sub-committee shall consider the referees and the officials for the competition under an approval of the organizing committee.

#### Article 12: Protest and appeal

The protest and appeal shall be based upon Section 8 and Section 10 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2568 (2025).

### Article 13: Penalty

The penalty shall be based upon Section 9 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2568 (2025).

Article 14: Chairperson of the 26<sup>th</sup> Thailand Sports School Games Organizing Committee shall have charge and control of the execution of this regulation and act as an arbiter in case of any problems which may occur from applying this regulation.
