



The 26th Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Archery

Whereas it is expedient to have the 26th Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Archery;

By virtue of Article 9 (2) of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2568 (2025), the regulation has been issued as follows:

Article 1: This regulation is called “the 26th Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Archery”.

Article 2: This regulation shall be enforced in the 26th Thailand Sports School Games on Archery.

Article 3: Rules and regulation of the competition

3.1 The 26th Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Archery shall be applied.

3.2 The rules of the World Archery Federation (WA) shall be applied.

3.3 The 26th Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Archery shall be applied in case of disagreement.

Article 4: Age groups, types, and events of the competition

4.1 Ages are classified into 3 groups as follows:

4.1.1 U14 (not born before 2011)

4.1.2 U16 (born between 2009 - 2010)

4.1.3 U18 (born between 2007 - 2008)

4.2 The competition is divided into 2 types as follows:

4.2.1 Recurve, 18m distance

Article 5: The number of athletes and team officials

5.1 For individual event of the recurve, each sports school is permitted to send athletes to participate at a maximum of 8 athletes in one age group (a maximum of 4 men and 4 women).

5.2 For individual event of the compound, each sports school is permitted to send athletes to participate at a maximum of 4 athletes in one age group (a maximum of 2 men and 2 women).

5.3 For team event of the recurve, each sports school is permitted to send 1 men's team and 1 women's team in one age group to participate. Each team is required to have at least 3 athletes and not more than 4 athletes in each event.

5.4 For mixed team event of the recurve, each sports school is permitted to send 1 mixed team in one age group to participate. Each team is required to have at least 2 athletes (1 man and 1 woman).

5.5 For mixed team event of the compound, each sports school is permitted to send 1 mixed team in one age group to participate. Each team is required to have at least 2 athletes (1 man and 1 woman).

5.6 Athletes are permitted to compete in one age group only.

5.7 Team officials of each sports school consist of:

5.7.1 Team manager	1	person
5.7.2 Coach	3	person
5.7.3 Assistant coach	3	person

Article 6: Qualifications of athletes

The qualifications shall be based upon Section 5 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E 2568 (2025).

Article 7: The competition prizes

7.1 Winning athletes shall receive the competition prizes in accordance with Section 7, Article 22 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2568 (2025) as follows:

7.1.1 The winner shall receive a gold medal and a certificate.

7.1.2 The first runner-up shall receive a silver medal and a certificate.

7.1.3 The second runner-up shall receive a bronze medal and a certificate.

7.2 Sports school which has the highest total scores shall receive a trophy of honor in accordance with Section 7, Article 23 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2568 (2025). The point calculation shall be as follows:

7.2.1 The winner gets	5	points
7.2.2 The 1 st runner-up gets	3	points
7.2.3 The 2 nd runner-up gets	1	point

7.3 Best athlete and coach awards

The best athlete and coach shall receive a certificate of honor under the criteria of consideration as follows:

7.3.1 The best athlete awards shall be given to three men and three women in accordance with their age groups (U14, U16, and U18).

7.3.2 The best coach awards shall be given to three men's coaches and three women's coaches.

7.3.3 The operating sub-committee in the archery sport technical sub-committee shall consider and operate for the best athlete and coach awards.

Article 8: The competition organizing methods

8.1 The competition organizing methods shall be based upon the World Archery Federation (WA).

8.2 In case of any problems that may occur during the archery competition each day, the sport technical sub-committee shall execute.

8.3 Each sports school that sends athletes to participate in the competition shall have to send team manager or team representative to attend team manager's meeting in accordance with stipulation of the sport technical sub-committee in order to acknowledge the practices and agreements as well as to confirm or submit the list of athletes who will compete in the team and individual events. Any sports school that does not attend the meeting without notification of any reasons shall have to accept the meeting's resolution.

8.4 Sports school that sends less than 3 athletes shall not be able to participate in the team event.

8.5 Athletes who participate in the team event shall be considered for the points both team and individual events at the same time.

8.6 Point calculation in the team event shall be counted from the best points of 3 athletes so as to calculate points in the team event.

8.7 In match round, rank 1 - 32 in the individual event shall be matched and rank 1 - 8 in the team and mixed team events shall be matched and compete in the format of elimination until getting the winner in rank 1 - 3.

8.8 Vertical triple face with the size of 40 cm shall be used.

8.9 The athlete who does not come and compete shall be disqualified from the competition.

Article 9: Determination of the competition date, time and venues

The organizing committee shall be responsible for determination of the competition date, time and venues.

Article 10: The competition uniform and equipment

10.1 Athletes shall have to wear the uniform provided by their sports school.

10.2 The competition equipment shall be based upon the World Archery Federation (WA).

Article 11: Referees and officials

The sport technical sub-committee shall consider the referees and the officials for the competition under an approval of the organizing committee.

Article 12: Protest and appeal

12.1 The protest and appeal shall be based upon Section 8 and Section 10 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2568 (2025).

12.2 Lodging the sport technical protest must be done within 15 minutes after the competition result has been officially announced.

Article 13: Penalty

The penalty shall be based upon Section 9 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2568 (2025).

Article 14: Chairperson of the 26th Thailand Sports School Games Organizing Committee shall have charge and control of the execution of this regulation and act as an arbiter in case of any problems which may occur from applying this regulation.
