



The 27th Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Sepak Takraw

Whereas it is expedient to have the 27th Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Sepak Takraw;

By virtue of Article 9 (2) of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2568 (2025), the regulation has been issued as follows:

Article 1: This regulation is called “the 27th Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Sepak Takraw”.

Article 2: This regulation shall be enforced in the 27th Thailand Sports School Games on Sepak Takraw.

Article 3: Rules and regulation of the competition

3.1 The 27th Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Sepak Takraw shall be applied.

3.2 The rules of the Takraw Association of Thailand shall be applied.

3.3 The 27th Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Sepak Takraw shall be applied in case of disagreement.

Article 4: Age groups, types, and events of the competition

4.1 Ages are classified into 3 groups as follows:

4.1.1 U14 (not born before 2012)

4.1.2 U16 (born between 2010 - 2011)

4.1.3 U18 (born between 2008 - 2009)

4.2 The competition is divided into 2 types as follows:

4.2.1 Men’s team

4.2.2 Women’s team

4.3 The Competition is divided into 3 events as follows:

4.3.1 Team

4.3.2 Regu

4.3.3 Quadrant

Article 5: The number of athletes and team officials

5.1 Each sports school is permitted to enter one men's team and one women's team in each age group. Participating athletes are permitted to compete in only one age group and in a maximum of two events.

5.2 For Team event, each team shall register a minimum of nine (9) athletes and a maximum of fifteen (15) athletes in the system, and shall confirm a final list of twelve (12) athletes on the day of the team manager's meeting.

5.3 For Regu event, each team shall register a minimum of three (3) athletes and a maximum of seven (7) athletes in the system, and shall confirm a final list of five (5) athletes on the day of the team manager's meeting, in accordance with the official roster. The submitted list must not include any athletes who are also registered in the Quadrant event.

5.4 For Quadrant event, each team shall register a minimum of four (4) athletes and a maximum of eight (8) athletes in the system, and shall confirm a final list of six (6) athletes on the day of the team manager's meeting, in accordance with the official roster. The submitted list must not include any athletes who are also registered in the Regu event.

5.5 Sports schools and sports schools under other affiliated organizations that register a team in the Team event pursuant to Clause 5.2 shall compete in accordance with the competition schedule. Failure to do so shall render them ineligible to compete in the Regu and Quadrant events.

5.6 Only athletes listed in the Team event roster are eligible to compete in the Regu and Quadrant events.

5.7 Team officials in each age group consist of:

Article 6: Qualifications of athletes

The qualifications shall be based upon Section 5 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2568 (2025).

Article 7: The competition prizes

7.1 Winning athletes shall receive the competition prizes in accordance with Section 7, Article 22 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2568 (2025) as follows:

- 7.1.1 The winner shall receive a gold medal and a certificate.
- 7.1.2 The first runner-up shall receive a silver medal and a certificate.
- 7.1.3 The second runner-up shall receive a bronze medal and a certificate.

7.2 The best athlete awards shall be given to three (3) male athletes and three (3) female athletes in accordance with their age groups (U14, U16 and U18) under the criteria of consideration as follows:

- 7.2.1 Count from the number of medals respectively
- 7.2.2 Behave properly as a good Sepak Takraw athlete
- 7.2.3 Be an athlete with excellent performance

7.2.4 Others in accordance with the resolution of the organizing sub-committee's meeting. Regarding the award in Clause 7.2, the Sepak Takraw organizing sub-committee shall operate.

7.3 The best athlete awards shall be given to three (3) men's coaches and three (3) women's coaches under the criteria of consideration as follows:

7.3.1 The number of medals received

7.3.2 Behave properly as a good Sepak Takraw coach

7.3.3 Others in accordance with the resolution of the organizing sub-committee's meeting. Regarding the award in Clause 7.3, the Sepak Takraw organizing sub-committee shall operate.

7.4 Sports school which has the highest total scores shall receive a trophy of honor in accordance with Section 7, Article 23 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2568 (2025). The criteria of consideration shall be as follows:

Sports school which receives the most gold medals shall be considered a winner. If the number of gold medals is equal, the number of silver and bronze medals shall be considered respectively. And if the number of all medal types is equal, the trophy of honor shall be occupied together.

Article 8: The competition organizing methods

8.1 The competition organizing methods shall be based upon Section 2, Article 12 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E 2568 (2025).

8.2 Team event

8.2.1 If participating teams are not more than five (5) teams, a round-robin competition shall be organized. The team which has a score in the first place shall receive the winning prize. The team which has a score in the second place shall receive the first runner-up prize. The team which has a score in the third place shall receive the second runner-up prize.

8.2.2 If participating teams are more than five (5) teams, the competition shall be organized as follows:

Round 1: a group division shall be made and a single round-robin competition in the group shall be organized. The teams having scores in first place and second place of each group shall get through to the next round.

Quarterfinal: an elimination competition shall be organized.

Semifinal: an elimination competition shall be organized.

Final: an elimination competition shall be organized.

8.3 Regu and Quadrant events

8.3.1 If participating teams are not more than five (5) teams, a single round-robin competition shall be organized. Team having scores in first place shall receive the winning prize. Team having scores in second place shall receive the first runner-up prize. Team having scores in third place shall receive the second runner-up prize.

8.3.2 If participating teams are more than five (5) teams, an elimination competition shall be organized. Teams being defeated in the semifinal shall receive the second runner-up prize. Team being defeated in the final shall receive the first runner-up prize.

8.4 Competition results shall be determined based on wins and losses as follows:

8.4.1 For Team events, matches shall be decided on a best-of-three-teams basis. Within each team, the result shall be decided on a best-of-three-sets basis. If a team wins both of the first two teams, the third team shall not be played.

8.4.2 For Regu event, matches shall be decided on a best-of-three-sets basis.

8.4.3 For Quadrant event, matches shall be decided on a best-of-three-sets basis.

8.5 Scoring for Sepak Takraw

- Winning team receives 2 points
- Losing team receives 1 point
- Team that does not attend the match receives 0 point

8.6 In the event of a tie, the winner shall be determined as follows:

8.6.1 In the event that two (2) teams are tied on points, the result of the head-to-head match between the teams shall be considered. The winning team shall be ranked higher.

8.6.2 In the event that three (3) teams are tied on points, the ranking order shall be determined by drawing lots.

8.7 The Team event shall be completed prior to the commencement of the Regu and Quadrant events.

8.8 The competition practices

8.8.1 Team managers or coaches shall have to attend the team manager's meeting on the stipulated date, time and venue, so as to get the competition information, appointment, and regulation. If not, they shall have to authorize other staffs to attend the meeting.

8.8.2 The sports school that has already confirmed the list of athletes on the day of team manager's meeting shall have to bring the team to compete on the stipulated date, time and venue, under the practices as follows:

1) All athletes shall have to report themselves according to the events of the competition.

2) Team manager or coach shall have to submit the list of athletes 30 minutes prior to the competition.

3) Any team that is not ready to compete or cannot come on time for competing, the organizing committee shall authorize to extend the time for 10 minutes. If the extended time is finished and that team is not ready for the competition, the team shall be judged as a losing team for that match but still has the eligibility to compete in the next match.

4) Any athlete of the team in the registered list who does not appear when the committee call or announce the name shall have to be disqualified from the competition. The consideration shall be made as follows: the team shall be judged as a losing team if any starting athlete in the team does not appear for the competition; if any substitute of the team does not appear for the competition, he/she shall be disqualified from that match but still has the eligibility to compete in the next match.

5) Any team that has an intent to walk out of the ongoing competition is considered serious misbehavior and shall have to be judged as a losing team in that match. Also, the incident shall be reported to the organizing committee for consideration of punishment as appropriate to the case.

6) Athletes shall have to bring AD Card, which is issued by the host or the Thailand National Sports University, and show it to the organizing committee

or assigned staff before entering the court and team officials shall also have to carry their own AD Card when performing duties.

7) Team officials or athletes of any teams misbehave or violate rules and regulations of the Thailand National Sports University shall have to be considered in accordance with Section 9, Article 31 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2568 (2025).

Article 9: Determination of the competition date, time and venues

The organizing committee shall be responsible for determination of the competition date, time and venues.

Article 10: The competition uniform and equipment

10.1 All athletes who are going to compete shall have to dress properly with the same uniform. Number on a jersey of each athlete both front and back sides (1 - 36) shall have to be clear and is not allowed to be changed with other numbers. Back side of the jersey shall have to be printed with the name of "athlete" or "institute" above the number. Trademark with the size not over 2x3 inches is allowed under the number on the front side.

10.2 All participating teams shall have to prepare at least 2 kits with clearly different colors for the competition. If two opponent teams wear in the same color, the host team shall have to change color of the kit. The team with the first name in the competition program shall have to change color of the kit in case of competing in a neutral venue. Any team that does not comply with this regulation shall be deemed to avoid the competition and shall be judged as a losing team in that match. The committee shall also report to that sports school for punishment.

10.3 Each team shall have to prepare an armband showing team's captain. The color of armband shall have to be clearly different from the color of jersey.

10.4 Team officials who are performing duty in the match shall have to dress properly. Shorts and flip flops are decisively prohibited. Any misbehaving team official shall not be allowed to perform the duty.

10.5 The competition equipment shall be based upon the Thailand National Sports University Announcement on Equipment Used in the 27th Thailand Sports School Games "Nakhonseekhwae Games".

Article 11: Referees and officials

The sport technical sub-committee shall consider the referees and the officials for the competition under an approval of the organizing committee.

Article 12: Protest and appeal

12.1 The protest and appeal shall be based upon Section 8 and Section 10 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2568 (2025).

12.2 Lodging the sport technical protest must be done within 12 hours after the competition result has been officially announced.

12.3 Lodging the athlete qualification protest must be done within 24 hours after the competition result has been officially announced.

Article 13: Penalty

The penalty shall be based upon Section 9 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2568 (2025).

Article 14: Chairperson of the 27th Thailand Sports School Games Organizing Committee shall have charge and control of the execution of this regulation and act as an arbiter in case of any problems which may occur from applying this regulation.
