



The 27th Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Archery

Whereas it is expedient to have the 27th Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Archery;

By virtue of Article 9 (2) of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2568 (2025), the regulation has been issued as follows:

Article 1: This regulation is called “the 27th Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Archery”.

Article 2: This regulation shall be enforced in the 27th Thailand Sports School Games on Archery.

Article 3: Rules and regulation of the competition

3.1 The 27th Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Archery shall be applied.

3.2 The rules of the World Archery Federation (WA) shall be applied.

3.3 The 27th Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Archery shall be applied in case of disagreement.

Article 4: Age groups, types, and events of the competition

4.1 Ages are classified into 3 groups as follows:

4.1.1 U14 (not born before 2012)

4.1.2 U16 (born between 2010 - 2011)

4.1.3 U18 (born between 2008 - 2009)

4.2 The competition is divided into 2 types as follows:

4.2.1 Recurve, 18m distance

Article 5: The number of athletes and team officials

5.1 For individual event of the recurve, each sports school is permitted to enter no more than eight athletes per age group (maximum 4 male and 4 female athletes).

5.2 For individual event of the compound, each sports school is permitted to enter no more than four athletes per age group (maximum 2 male and 2 female athletes).

5.3 For team event of the recurve, each sports school is permitted to enter one men's team and one women's team per age group. Each team must consist of at least three athletes and no more than four athletes in each event entered.

5.4 For mixed team event of the recurve, each sports school is permitted to enter one mixed team per age group. Each team must consist of at least two athletes (1 male and 1 female athletes).

5.5 For mixed team event of the compound, each sports school is permitted to enter one mixed team per age group. Each team must consist of at least two athletes (1 male and 1 female athletes).

5.6 Each athlete is permitted to compete in only one age group.

5.7 Team officials of each sports school consist of:

5.7.1 Team manager	1	person
5.7.2 Coach	3	person
5.7.3 Assistant coach	3	person

Article 6: Qualifications of athletes

The qualifications shall be based upon Section 5 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E 2568 (2025).

Article 7: The competition prizes

7.1 Winning athletes shall receive the competition prizes in accordance with Section 7, Article 22 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2568 (2025) as follows:

7.1.1 The winner shall receive a gold medal and a certificate.

7.1.2 The first runner-up shall receive a silver medal and a certificate.

7.1.3 The second runner-up shall receive a bronze medal and a certificate.

7.2 Sports school which has the highest total scores shall receive a trophy of honor in accordance with Section 7, Article 23 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2568 (2025). The point calculation shall be as follows:

7.2.1 The winner gets	5	points
7.2.2 The 1 st runner-up gets	3	points
7.2.3 The 2 nd runner-up gets	1	point

7.3 Best athlete and coach awards

The best athlete and coach shall receive a certificate of honor under the criteria of consideration as follows:

7.3.1 The best athlete awards shall be given to three male athletes and three female athletes in accordance with their age groups (U14, U16, and U18).

7.3.2 The best coach awards shall be given to three men's coaches and three women's coaches.

7.3.3 The operating sub-committee in the archery sport technical sub-committee shall consider and operate for the best athlete and coach awards.

Article 8: The competition organizing methods

8.1 The competition organizing methods shall be based upon the World Archery Federation (WA).

8.2 In the event of any issues arising during the archery competition on any given day, the sport technical sub-committee shall consider and take appropriate action.

8.3 Each sports school entering athletes in the competition must send a team manager or representative to attend the team manager's meeting as scheduled by the sport technical sub-committee in order to acknowledge rules, procedures, and agreements, as well as to confirm or submit the list of athletes for both team and individual events. Any sports school that fails to attend the meeting without valid reason shall be deemed to have accepted the resolutions of the meeting.

8.4 Any sports school entering fewer than three athletes shall not be eligible to compete in the team event.

8.5 Athletes participating in the team event shall have their scores counted simultaneously for both team and individual events.

8.6 Team scores shall be calculated based on the results of the top three athletes in each team.

8.7 The elimination rounds (match rounds) shall be conducted based on individual ranking positions 1-32, paired accordingly. For team and mixed team events, ranking 1-8 shall be paired in a knockout format until the winners for places 1-3 are determined.

8.8 Vertical triple face with the size of 40 cm shall be used.

8.9 Any athlete who does not compete shall be deemed to have withdrawn from the competition.

Article 9: Determination of the competition date, time and venues

The organizing committee shall be responsible for determination of the competition date, time and venues.

Article 10: The competition uniform and equipment

10.1 Athletes shall have to wear the uniform provided by their sports school.

10.2 The competition equipment shall be based upon the World Archery Federation (WA).

Article 11: Referees and officials

The sport technical sub-committee shall consider the referees and the officials for the competition under an approval of the organizing committee.

Article 12: Protest and appeal

12.1 The protest and appeal shall be based upon Section 8 and Section 10 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2568 (2025).

12.2 Lodging the sport technical protest must be done within 15 minutes after the competition result has been officially announced.

Article 13: Penalty

The penalty shall be based upon Section 9 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2568 (2025).

Article 14: Chairperson of the 27th Thailand Sports School Games Organizing Committee shall have charge and control of the execution of this regulation and act as an arbiter in case of any problems which may occur from applying this regulation.
