



The 27th Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Swimming

Whereas it is expedient to have the 27th Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Swimming;

By virtue of Article 9 (2) of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2568 (2025), the regulation has been issued as follows:

Article 1: This regulation is called “the 27th Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Swimming”.

Article 2: This regulation shall be enforced in the 27th Thailand Sports School Games on Swimming.

Article 3: Rules and regulation of the competition

3.1 The 27th Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Swimming shall be applied.

3.2 The rules of the World Aquatics shall be applied.

3.3 The 27th Thailand Sports School Games Regulation on Swimming shall be applied in case of disagreement.

Article 4: Age groups, types, and events of the competition

4.1 Ages are classified into 3 groups as follows:

4.1.1 U14 (not born before 2012)

4.1.2 U16 (born between 2010 - 2011)

4.1.3 U18 (born between 2008 - 2009)

4.2 The competition is divided into 2 types as follows;

4.2.1 Individual

1) Men’s individual

2) Women’s individual

4.2.2 Team

1) Men’s team

2) Women’s team

3) Mixed doubles’ team

4.3 The competition events are as follows:

Article 5: The number of athletes and team officials

5.1 A maximum of thirty (30) athletes in each age group is permitted in the competition. The above-mentioned number shall be divided into a maximum of 15 men and a maximum of 15 women.

5.2 For individual types, a maximum of two (2) athletes is permitted to register in each event.

5.3 For team types, a maximum of one (1) team is permitted to register in each event.

5.4 Each athlete is permitted to compete in no more than five (5) events in total, whether individual or team types, and must compete only in their respective age group.

5.5 Team officials in each age group are as follows:

5.1.1 Team manager 1 person

5.1.2 Coach 1 person

5.1.3 Assistant coach 1 person

Article 6: Qualifications of athletes

The qualifications shall be based upon Section 5 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E 2568 (2025).

Article 7: The competition prizes

7.1 Winning athletes shall receive the competition prizes in accordance with Section 7, Article 22 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2568 (2025) as follows:

7.1.1 The winner shall receive a gold medal and a certificate.

7.1.2 The first runner-up shall receive a silver medal and a certificate.

7.1.3 The second runner-up shall receive a bronze medal and a certificate.

7.2 Sports school which has the highest total scores shall receive a trophy of honor in accordance with Section 7, Article 23 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2568 (2025). The point calculation shall be as follows:

School Games gets	7.2.1 The winner by breaking the record of Thailand Sports	50	points
	7.2.2 The winner gets	10	points
	7.2.3 The 1 st runner-up gets	2	points
	7.2.4 The 2 nd runner-up gets	1	point

7.3 Best athlete and coach awards

The best athlete and coach shall receive a certificate of honor under the criteria of consideration as follows:

7.3.1 The best athlete awards shall be given to three male athletes and three female athletes in accordance with their age groups (U14, U16, and U18).

7.3.2 The best coach awards shall be given to three men's coaches and three women's coaches.

7.3.3 The operating sub-committee in the swimming sport technical sub-committee shall consider and operate for the best athlete and coach awards.

Article 8: The competition organizing methods

8.1 Records shall be certified by the Thailand Swimming Association.

8.2 The competition shall be conducted as Time Final (no preliminary heats), using the competition program of the Thailand Swimming Association.

8.3 Lane assignments shall be conducted in accordance with the rules of World Aquatics.

8.4 Athletes must report 30 minutes prior to the start of their event.

8.5 The One Start Rule shall be applied for releasing.

8.6 Each event must have athletes from at least three sports schools. Any event with athletes from fewer than three sports schools shall be considered an exhibition.

8.7 Automatic timing equipment shall be used.

8.8 Any issues arising shall be decided by the sport technical sub-committee, whose decision shall be final.

Article 9: Determination of the competition date, time and venues

The organizing committee shall be responsible for determination of the competition date, time and venues.

Article 10: The competition uniform and equipment

The competition uniform and equipment shall be in accordance with the rules and regulation of the World Aquatics.

Article 11: Referees and officials

The sport technical sub-committee shall consider the referees and the officials for the competition under an approval of the organizing committee.

Article 12: Protest and appeal

The protest and appeal shall be based upon Section 8 and Section 10 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2568 (2025).

Article 13: Penalty

The penalty shall be based upon Section 9 of the Thailand National Sports University Regulation on Thailand Sports School Games, B.E. 2568 (2025).

Article 14: Chairperson of the 27th Thailand Sports School Games Organizing Committee shall have charge and control of the execution of this regulation and act as an arbiter in case of any problems which may occur from applying this regulation.
